Please, come with the following documents and **a translation in French from a authorized translator**. Keep a copy with you, in case of you lose it. You can ask the French Embassy for a list of authorized translators.

### Non European scientists : « carte de séjour » (residence permit)

For your « carte de séjour » application, for your wife's application, for the stay of your children.

- a birth certificate translated into French by an authorized translator and certified
- a marriage certificate translated into French by an authorized translator and certified
- a family book record translated into French by an authorized translator and certified
- **The original document of your « protocole d'accueil »**, stamped by the Embassy during your scientist visa application

These documents are those given to the French Embassy for your visa application.

You will also need other documents for your « carte de séjour » application : proof of residence, ID photos, stamped envelops ... The BiCi desk will give you the list, once you are in France, depending on where you reside.

### Other administrative formalities

- Statements of the family income for the previous year/last tax notices, last wage slips
- A proof of your medical insurance during your stay in France

### For your children

- School reports of the children
- Records of vaccination
- Health record book
